### **Grammar Reminders/Sentence Construction for the Tours:**

1. **3B Vocab How does one go ...?/¿Cómo se va ....?** – Bueno, por la tarde, monta su ciclomotor. Maneja despacio, es peligroso. Para ir al Parque de Oakwood toma la calle Polk por 2 cuadras, dobla a la derecha en la calle de Brookside y queda a la izquierda. Ten cuidado con los perros. Me están poniendo nervioso.
2. **Commands:** Use the él/ella/ud form of the verb. Act 10 p165 in 3B: Toma, Maneja, Anda/Camina, Dobla, Queda, Saca, Espera, Mira, Pasa, Para, Sigue. (Take, Drive, Walk, Turn, Stay/Is on, Take out, Wait, Look, Pass, Stop, Continue)
3. **Prepositions:** p154 Turn to the right/Dobla a la derecha. Continue straight/Sigue derecho. The bank is on the left beside the supermarket/El banco queda a la izquierda, al lado del supermóercado.
4. **USE of the verb Tener** – I'm hungry, in a hurry, thirsty, sleepy, in pain, be careful/Tengo hambre, prisa, sed, sueño, dolor, cuidado. Bueno, Tengo hambre y sed por la tarde/Well, I'm hungry and thirsty this afternoon. How do you go to the restaurant on foot?/ ¿Cómo se va al restaurante a pie?
5. **Para + infinitiv3** – Reason/ In order to. In order to go the Oakwood Park/ Para ir al parque de Oakwood toma la calle de ...., dobla a la derecha...
6. **Be careful w/use of 2 infinitives** – ¿Cómo se va al banco? Bueno, quieres ir al banco./How does one go the bank? Well, You want to go to the bank? O ¿Te gusta ir al banco? ¿Prefiere ir al banco?/Or You want to go to the bank?/ You prefer to go to the bank?
7. **Uso de Direct Object Pronouns: Me, te, nos.** ¿Me ayuda? ¿Nos ayuda? Sí te ayudo. ¿Me dice cómo se va...? Me dice que se va... Te digo que se va... Nos dice que se va...
8. **Use of the Present Progressive** – Your passing/Estás pasando la calle de Elm. You're turning/Estoy doblando a la derecha. We are driving/Estamos manejando. You are walking/Está caminando.

7. **Use of Transition words** — Primeras, para ir al cementerio, toma la calle de Oakwood. Dobla, avvia a la calle de Linden. Despues de pasar el monumento para. Entonces, queda en medio del cementerio. Ahora, camina en el cementerio.

**An example of a description:** Ex 1: ¿Cómo se va al cementerio de Oakwood del Parque de Oakwood a pie? Te ayudo. ¿Te gusta ir al cementerio? Primero, para ir a pie, por la tarde es peligroso. Es mejor manejar. Pues, ten cuidado. Toma la calle de Watauga hasta llegar a la esquina de Brookside. Dobla a la derecha en la calle de Polk. Sigue derecho en la calle de Polk por 3 cuadras. Para al semáforo. Mira a los dos lados. :D. Despues, te digo que dobla a la derecha cuando está pasando la casa azul. Queda a la izquierda pero se cierra a las ocho. Ten prisa.

(How does one go to the Oakwood Cemetery from the Oakwood Dog Park on foot? I'll help you. You want to go to the cemetery? 1<sup>st</sup>, in order to go on foot in the afternoon, it's dangerous. It's better to drive. Then, be careful! Take Watauga Street until you arrive at the corner of Brookside. Turn right onto Polk Street. Continue straight on Polk St. for three blocks. Stop at the stop light. Look both ways! After that, I tell you to turn to the right when you are passing the blue house. The cemetery is on the left; closes at 8:00. Better hurry!)
